Flood preparation checklist



Vero cares about protecting your staff and business. Some floods develop slowly while others, like flash floods, can hit in an instant. This checklist should help equip you in case an emergency takes place.

①	Emergency kit Prepare an emergency kit (this can include first aid supplies, torch, battery operated radio, important documents and medicines)	
	Check utilities Identify where and how to turn off the mains supply for water, power and gas	
	Check vehicles Ensure vehicles are in good working order	
	Be prepared If a warning is issued for your area, ensure your mobile battery is full and you have a full tank of fuel	
	Check insurance Review your contents insurance regularly to ensure your sum insured is adequate	
	Check alerts Use local alerts and warning systems to keep up to date with information	
	Follow advice Follow emergency services' advice and evacuate immediately when directed	
	Don't take risks Be wary of rising waters when driving, and don't drive across flood waters	
	Protect items Bring any outdoor furniture inside and move essential items to an upper floor
